MCBC specializes in high quality reuse materials sourced locally: wood, lumber, plywood, windows, glass, stone, hardware, fixtures, architectural elements and more.

The cooperative is still in a start-up mode and without a collection and reuse center due losing our space at 816 B Street. Until a location and center is established we will be unable of course to accept your donated materials and products. In the mean time we recommend you contact the Away Station in Fairfax, another MARIN LOCAL C&D Recycling Facility.

When we do open all local MARIN (MCBC) members will be entitled to receive a 10% discount on all purchases. To establish your membership go to our SUPPORT page to register.
